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# School Uniform and P.E. Kit

We are aware that you will be getting ready to start purchasing uniform for September. We want to remind parents that we expect all children (Nursery to Year 6) to attend school in full school uniform including black shoes, not trainers.

#### School uniform should be:

- ✓ Purple Jumper or cardigan with or without the school logo
- ✓ White polo shirt, white blouse or white shirt
- ✓ Grey trousers or skirt.
- ✓ Black shoes

Children should not wear jewellery to school. Where they have their ears pierced, they should only wear stud earrings which should not be worn on PE or swimming days. Where they are, the children will have to have them taped up for PE or removed for swimming.

#### All children must have a PE kit that they can use for PE.

#### This should consist of:

- ✓ A plain white t-shirt with or without the school logo
- ✓ Black shorts
- √ Black jogging bottoms and zip up hooded top for colder weather (plain, not branded)
- √ Trainers for outdoors (these do not need to be expensive branded trainers)
- ✓ Black pumps for indoor PE



We have a large amount of pre loved uniform that is available to you. If you would like to take a look at this, please ask at the school office. This will also be available at the summer fair on the 6<sup>th</sup> July.
