



We are pleased to invite your Reception child to join the Children's University which is an international organisation that provides pupils with access to exciting and innovative learning activities and experiences outside the normal school day. These learning activities are being provided by the school as well as other organisations.

All of our pupils will have the opportunity to take part in the Children's University and extra-curricular activities throughout the academic year. Children will collect digital stamps to demonstrate the number of hours of learning they have achieved in validated Children's University activities. For example, after taking part in a school sports day or in Children in Need fundraising, your child will receive a number of hours towards their award.

There are 12 levels within the CU scheme. Each level is made up of 3 awards.

100hrs=Gold.

65hrs=Silver. 30hrs=Bronze







We have entered our second year of Children's University, many pupils are close to their first award and one pupil, Amayah Mills, is just 7 hours from receiving her gold. To collect more stamp codes, pupils must enter as many extra curricular activities as possible.



Year I received their iPads in the first week of term. They are just beginning their Learning Futures journey and have recently been learning iPad skills, including the Speak Selection tool.

Year 4 have started to learn the Steel Pans with our teacher, Owen Clarke, from Services for Education. He will also run an after-school club for Year 5 children, this year, who wish to continue from previous lessons.


