

## Dear parents/carers,

I apologise for any confusion caused with the kit list that was sent out before the holidays. The items that were suggested were on there to cover all of the activities that Woodlands offer. As we won't be participating in any water or underground activities, there are some items that the children do not need. I have amended the list below.

Please make your judgement on the day - if it is sunny then ensure your child has appropriate sun protection and plenty to drink; if it is wet/cold then again appropriate clothing to keep them warm/dry.

Please make sure that your child wears suitable footwear (trainers/boots) that can be securely fastened. If your child is wearing unsuitable footwear, then we will need to wait for an alternative to arrive which could delay our trip.

Raincoats: please don't feel you need to go out and buy anything new for the trip. They will just need a coat that will keep them dry if it rains but isn't too big/heavy if they don't want to wear it.

Please remember, whatever your child takes with them, they will need to carry with them all day so please ensure that they have a suitable bag to carry this in.

## Recommended Kit for Day/Half Day Visits and Birthday Parties
