Miss Jenkins as class teacher in year 1 and Mrs Azfal and Mrs Harees as lunchtime supervisors.

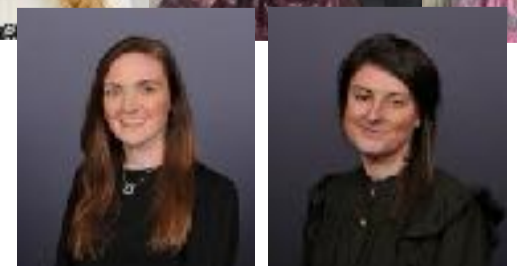
Mrs Campbell joins us as a Learning Mentor.

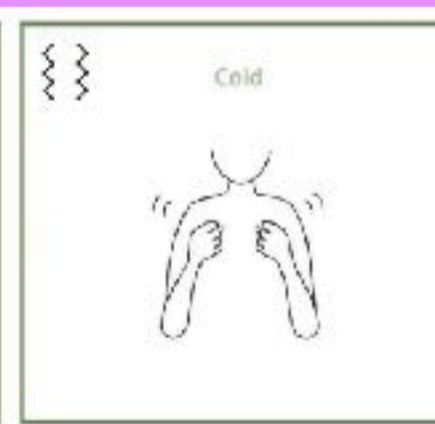
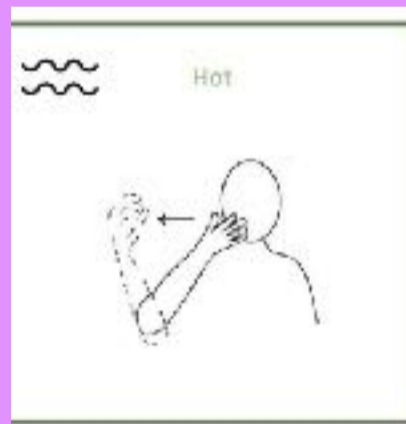
Let's talk Makaton
