Applications

When considering the secondary school you would like your child to go to there are some key things you should do:

- Research the school look online and take time to visit the school
- Make a realistic application consider how close the school is to your home, look at the admissions criteria and previous admissions patterns
- Apply online by the deadline date of 31st October 2021 (up to 11:59pm)

It is really important that you apply on time. If you apply late you are less likely to get offered a place at any of your preferred schools.

We are working hard to ensure children are in school learning. You can help us to make sure they are and help us to achieve our whole school target of at least **97%** attendance.

Polite Punctuality Reminder

Please ensure that your child arrives to school on time each morning. They lose valuable learning time when they arrive late.

Can all parents and carers also ensure they collect their child on time at the end of each day. The teachers have work and training to complete at the end of the school day but cannot do this if they have children who have not been collected. It is also upsetting for children when they are collected late.

School Uniform reminder

We expect all children (Nursery to Year 6) to attend school in full school uniform including black shoes, not trainers.

School uniform should be:

- ✓ Purple Jumper or cardigan with or without the school logo
- ✓ White polo shirt, white blouse or white shirt
- ✓ Grey trousers or skirt. Skirts should be knee length.
- ✓ Black shoes

Children should not wear jewelry to school. Where they have their ears pierced, they should only wear stud earrings which should not be worn on PE days. Where they are, the children will have to have them taped up.





All children should have a PE kit that they can use for PE. This should consist of:

- ✓ A white t-shirt with or without the school logo
- ✓ Black shorts
- Black jogging bottoms and zip up hooded top for colder weather
- ✓ Trainers for outdoors (these do not need to be expensive branded trainers)
- ✓ Black pumps for indoor PE





All children are given a Slade water bottle when they join us in Reception. However, if you would like to purchase a new water bottle, you can do so from the school office at a cost of £1.
