



## Acceptable Use Agreement KS2



- ✓ Slade Primary School will help me stay safe when I'm using any ICT in school
- ✓ I know that Slade Primary School will monitor my use of ICT in school
- ✓ I will NEVER give my username and password away to ANYONE
- ✓ I will not deliberately type or search for anything that is bad or inappropriate
- ✓ I will take care of ALL ICT equipment
- ✓ I am aware that some websites and social networks have age restrictions and I should respect this
- ✓ I will not attempt to visit web sites that I know to be banned by school



- ✓ If someone tries to talk to me on the computer that I don't know, I will ignore them and tell an adult
- ✓ I will not give out any information about me to any strangers at any time (full names, address, age, email address, phone number)
- ✓ I will be polite and not use nasty or bad words when typing or talking to my friends
- ✓ I will only email people I know, or a responsible adult has approved



- ✓ If I am not sure about an email, attachment, picture or message I will tell an adult straight away
- ✓ I will not click on any pop ups that may appear on my screen
- ✓ I know that some websites and social networks are for grown-ups, and won't look at any sites or play games with age ratings more than my age



- ✓ Not all information that I see online is true, I will make sure I check more than one website to check it's real



- ✓ If I am worried or upset by something I see on the computers, I will use Hector and tell an adult straight away
- ✓ If I am worried or upset about something on any ICT equipment, I will tell an adult straight away
- ✓ I know where to find and how to use the CEOP report abuse button.
