Update on Relationships Education.

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to you to update you on the development and delivery of the Relationships Education curriculum which is compulsory from September 2020.

In light of the current COVID-19 situation, the government issued an update last week for schools with regards to the delivery of the curriculum which in summary states, from 1 September 2020, Relationships Education, Health Education, and Relationships and Sex Education will still be compulsory. However: from 1st September 2020 to the end of the spring term 2021 schools should prepare to deliver the new curriculum. This includes engaging parents on the policy as well as planning their curriculum provision. By the start of summer term 2021, all schools should have begun teaching the subjects.

Mrs Khan has been working with staff and governors to develop our Relationships Education curriculum and will be consulting with parents over the summer term and into September to ensure we have taken into consideration all stakeholders thoughts and comments on our curriculum.

Please be assured, that parents will be consulted with before the curriculum is finalised and delivered.
