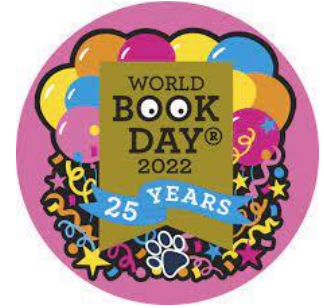

As school was closed on Thursday 3rd March for the by-election, we held our World Book Day events on Friday 4th March so that the children did not miss out.

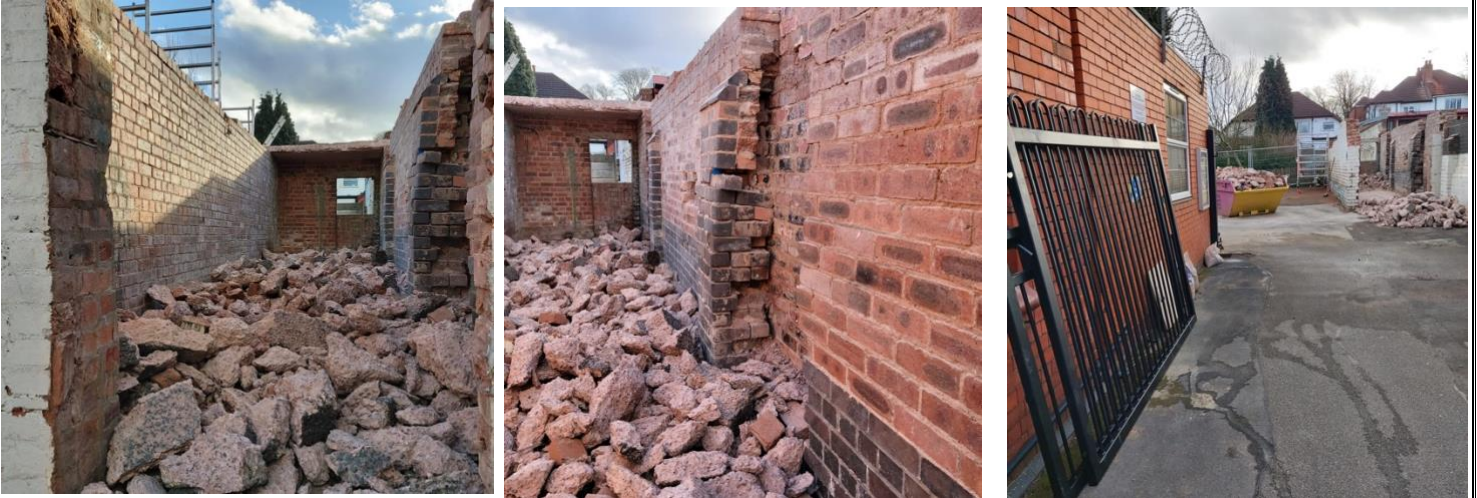
